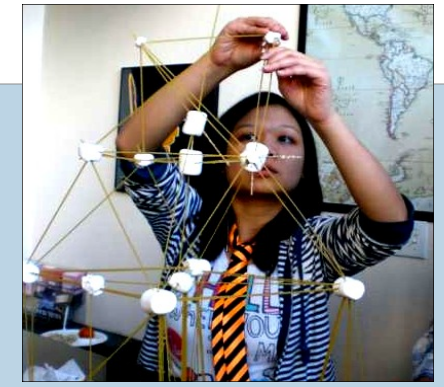

Appropriate Emotions - God will help us to have the right kind of feelings.

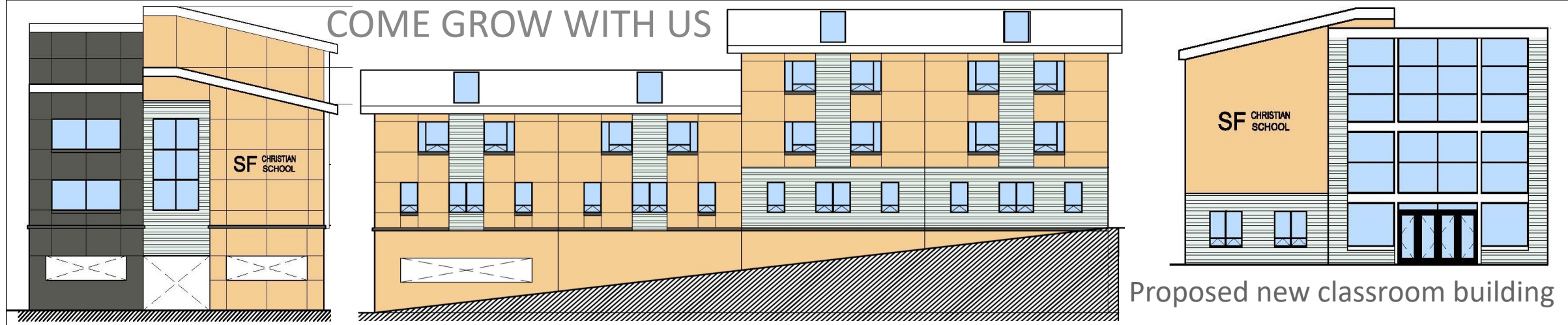


Relational Focus - We should love God and love others.
